Schools eligible for this category are Title I participating schools that are under improvement. There were 35 eligible schools. The 35 schools were ranked on the dimensions of English/language arts and mathematics proficiency rates and the three year slope (trend over the last three years of DSTP, 2008-2010). The school with highest percent proficient for 2011 on DCAS was given a rank of 1, and the school with the lowest percent proficient was given a rank of 35 (*Ranking for 2011 % Proficient*). The school with the largest (improving) slope value was given a rank of 1 and the school with the smallest (regressing) slope value was given a rank of 35 (*Ranking for Three Year Slope*). An overall average ranking (*Average Ranking*) was created for each school by taking the average for the ranking for *Ranking for 2011 % Proficient* and *Ranking for Three Year Slope*. The lowest- achieving schools for this category were determined by taking the five schools with the highest overall *Average Ranking*. The five schools are listed above. Eligible schools could also be listed as lowest-achieving if the school had a graduation rate less than 60% for two of the last three years. There were no schools in this category that met the graduation rate criterion.

Schools eligible for this category are middle and high schools that are eligible for Title I funds (i.e., Poverty rate  $\geq 35\%$ ) but are not participating in Title I. There were 26 eligible schools. The 26 schools were ranked on the dimensions of English/language arts and mathematics proficiency rates and the three year slope (trend over the last three years of DSTP, 2008-2010). The school with highest percent proficient for 2011 was given a rank of 1, and the school with the lowest percent proficient was given a rank of 26 (*Ranking for 2011 % Proficient*). The school with the largest (improving) slope value was given a rank of 1 and the school with the smallest (regressing) slope value was given a rank of 26 (*Ranking for Three Year Slope*). An overall average ranking (*Average Ranking*) was created for each school by taking the average for the ranking for *Ranking for 2011 % Proficient* and *Ranking for Three Year Slope*. The lowest- achieving schools for this category were determined by taking the five schools with the highest overall *Average Ranking*. The five schools are listed above. Eligible schools could also be listed as lowest-achieving if the school had a graduation rate less than 60% for two of the last three years. There were no schools in this category that met the graduation rate criterion.
